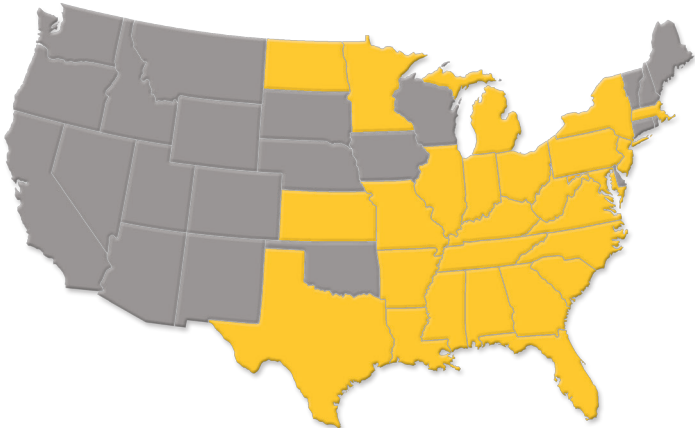


Safety and Training

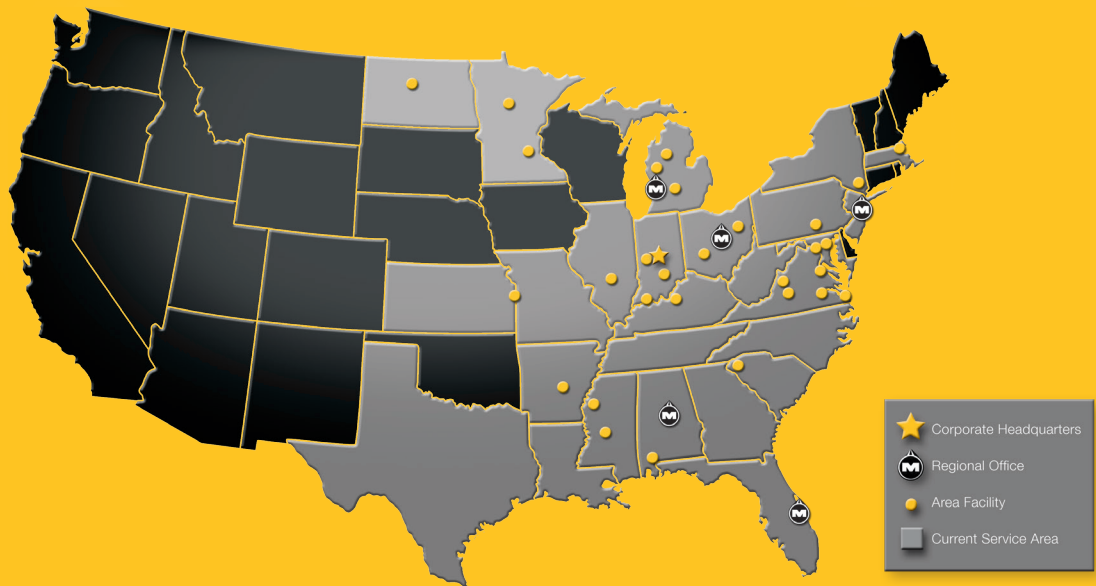
